

# The Oak Park Recorder School – 2017 Scholarship Information

## Main Goals of the Fund

To provide scholarships for beginning or advanced recorder students who plan serious study of the recorder in conjunction with attendance at the *Early Music Festival* held at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater.

## Rules Governing Applications and Distribution of Funds:

- ❖ An Application Form shall be filled out and returned to Pamela Wiese, 411 Ashland Ave 5D, River Forest IL, 60305, (708) 386-1297, no later than May 1, 2017.
- ❖ The application must include how the money, if granted, would be used as well as information about the person's playing ability, future plans for playing the recorder, and reasons for the request.
- ❖ Each application must be sponsored by a current member of the American Recorder Society or someone who has attended the Early Music Festival.
- ❖ A limit of \$400 will be set aside by the Oak Park Recorder School for 2017 scholarships, the distribution and amount of which will be determined after all applications have been received. The maximum amount of any such scholarship or grant awarded shall be half the full double-occupancy tuition less the mandatory deposit for the workshop.
- ❖ Once an individual or family has received an award, subsequent years' awards may be given preference to an applicant who has never received an award prior.
- ❖ Scholarships or grants shall be decided by majority vote of the Board of the Oak Park Recorder School after receipt of an application requesting the funds.

## Rules Governing Management of the Fund

- ❖ An account of the Fund will be kept as a separate entry by the Treasurer and reported in the Annual Treasurer's Report.
- ❖ An announcement will be placed in the mailing for the workshop, the announcement of the workshop in the National Magazine of the American Recorder Society and the April and May issues of the *Recorder Reporter* (newsletter of the Chicago and West Suburban Chapters of the ARS) to encourage individuals to apply for scholarships or grants.
- ❖ Contributions (anonymous or otherwise) are welcome, and any waived deposits to the workshop should be set aside and included in the following year's scholarship funds.
- ❖ The Board is not obligated to grant awards or assistance every year.
- ❖ In the event the Oak Park Recorder School disbands, the money previously set aside for scholarships will be given to the National ARS Scholarship Fund.
- ❖ If a person to whom a grant is made is unable to attend the workshop, the person is obligated to return the grant to the chapter.
